ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

We, the undersigned, Florence Orr, of 3001 E. 15th Ave., Anchorage, Alaska 99501, Gerald Markee, of 1018 "G" Street, Anchorage, Alaska, 99501, and Mary Carle of 1038 Beech Lane, Anchorage, Alaska 99501, have determined to form and incorporate a non-profit corporation as set forth and described herein.

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be ANCHOR-AGE CENTER.

ARTICLE II

The duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE III

The purpose of the corporation shall be to improve the living conditions of all elderly people, and to serve as a community focal point for all senior citizens of the Anchorage municipality in an effort to bring their lifestyle to the maximum expectation; to manage and operate a Senior Center or centers, including recreational, cultural, physical fitness, social, craft, literary and educational programs.

ARTICLE IV.

The registered office of the corporation shall be at 1300 East 19th Avenue, Anchorage, Alaska 99504, and the registered agent at said address shall be Florence Orr.

ARTICLE V

The initial Board of Directors shall consist of three members.

However, the By-Laws may fix the number of directors at eleven. The initial Board of Directors shall consist of the following individuals, Florence Orr, of 3001 East 15th Avenue, Anchorage, Alaska 99504, Gerald Markee, of 1018 "G" Street, Anchorage, Alaska 99501, and Mary Carle, of 1038 Beech Lane, Anchorage, Alaska 99501.

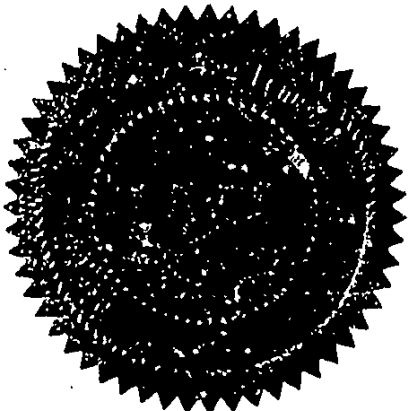
