

Expectations for Board members

1. Be a member in good standing of the ASAC.
2. Support the annual financial goals of the ASAC. Examples include:
 - a. Make a personal contribution.
 - b. Ask others to give when appropriate and to the best of their ability.
 - c. Support fund raising activities of the ASAC.
3. Share networks and resources that could benefit the ASAC.
4. Be an advocate and share your passion about the organization and mission.
5. Assist with saying “Thank You” to donors by making calls and sending letters as appropriate.
6. Actively participate in Board meetings, including contributing to the discussions.
7. Support ASAC events by being visible and engaging.
8. Attend the Annual Signature event as a ticketholder or volunteer. Encourage other to buy tickets and tables, and assist with solicitation of auction items.
9. Attend and take part in the Annual Board Retreat.
10. Chair or serve on at least one committee.
11. Consider serving as an officer for at least 1 year of the three-year term.
